Following is information the Town of Edgewood has compiled with help from our rate advisors:

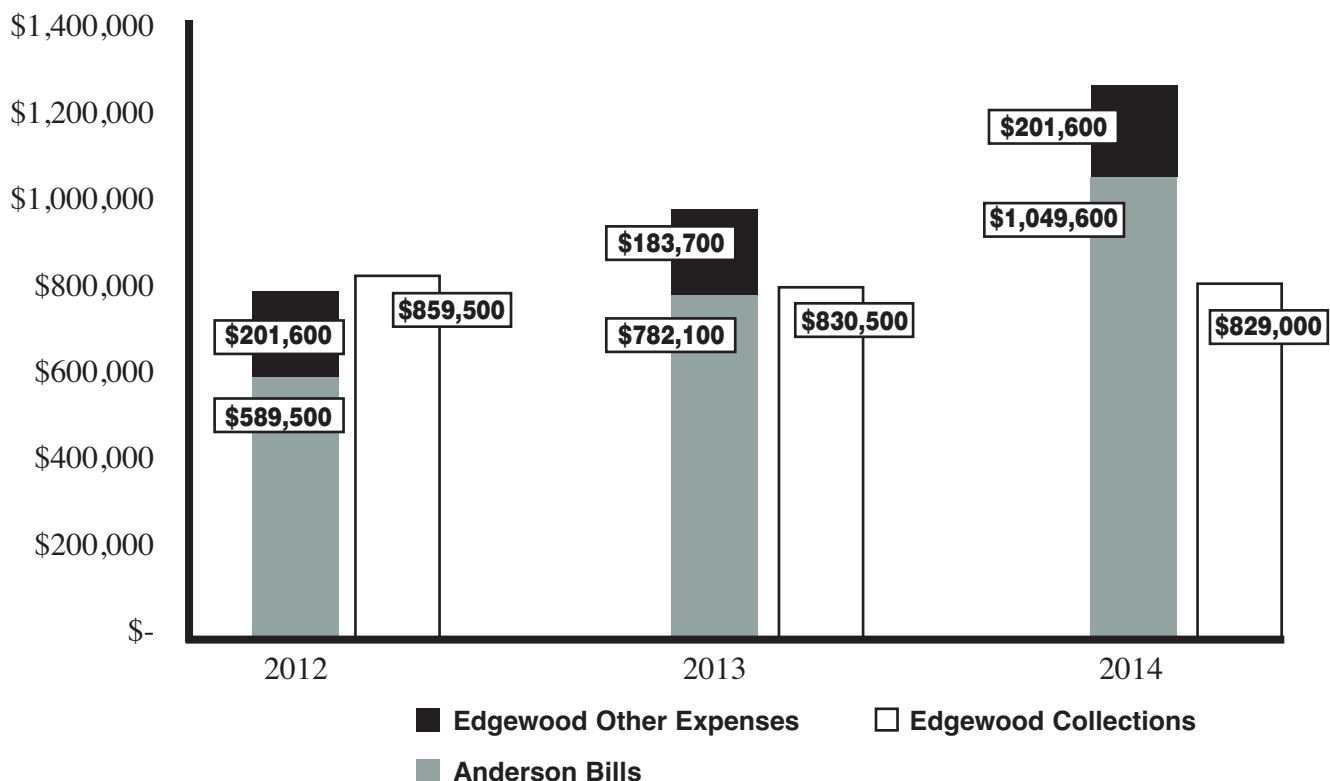
TOWN OF EDGEWOOD WATER RATE INCREASE

An increase in water rates is currently necessary due to increases in costs related to periodic maintenance, health and dental insurance and contractual services as well as capital improvements and replacements needed for the water utility infrastructure. Since the last water rate increase in November, 2010 operation and maintenance expenses have increased and the water utility is not collecting enough revenue to provide for the costs of the water utility. Therefore, the Town is planning a three-phase rate increase which will result in the average bill for 4,000 gallons to be increased from \$3.50 per 1000 gallons to \$4.90 per 1000 gallons effective upon adoption of the ordinance, \$5.70 per 1000 gallons effective January 1, 2016 and \$6.50 per 1000 gallons effective January 1, 2017. These rate increases will provide revenues for the Water Utility to cover expenses related to annual operating and maintenance as well as the capital improvements and replacements needed for the water utility infrastructure.

TOWN OF EDGEWOOD TWO PHASE SEWAGE RATE INCREASE

An increase in sewage rates is necessary due to increases in inflow and infiltration and the resulting costs to be paid to Anderson Utilities for treatment. The Town is planning a sewer project to decrease inflow and infiltration but rate increases are needed to provide for expenses related to operation and maintenance of the sewage works. Current collections do not meet the costs of sewage operations as shown in the chart below. As a result of inflow and infiltration and the need to meet operation and maintenance expenses, the Town is planning a two phase rate increase of 34% effective upon adoption of the proposed ordinance and a 6% rate increase upon completion of the sewage project. There will be a public hearing at the Baptist Church regarding the rate increase on April 27, 2015 at 5:00 p.m. The meeting is open to the public.

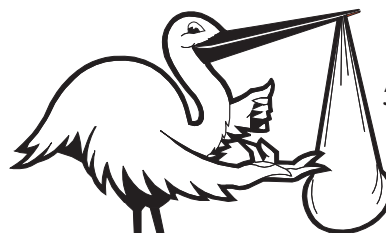
