Fire Department News

The Edgewood Fire and EMS would like to thank each of you that attended our Dan's Fish Fry this past September. It was a great turnout and we appreciate your support.

As you drive down Highway 32 you will notice the fire station has a new look. The improvement to the building is not limited to the outside. We are doing what we can to update inside too. In the small front bay you will see a newer Ford ambulance, Edgewood Ambulance 95. We will keep Ambulance 94 and it will serve as a backup vehicle. The EMS staff here at Station 90 is happy to have this new ambulance so that we may better serve the community.

In the early days, the Edgewood Volunteer Fire Department had, and kept, a 1959 Howe fire engine for 28 years. They replaced that engine with a new FMC fire engine in 1987. Another 28 years have gone by and it is time to replace the now old FMC engine. Paperwork has been started and soon Edgewood will be ordering a new tanker pumper.

Remember to check your smoke detectors often, and as always, dial 911 in an emergency.

PARKING

Winter and snow have arrived, and as always we need your assistance in keeping the roads clear.

There is no parking allowed on the paved or main traveled part of any street within the town. Please make sure you are following this ordinance so the streets can be thoroughly cleared by the snow plows. Any resident may file a written request for on-street vehicle parking for periods not to exceed eight hours.

Also, remember that snowmobiles are not allowed to be parked or driven in the parks and recreational areas, and should not be driven on the roads. Be sure you have permission from the owners if you are riding them on private property.
