Happy New Year! Now that 2013 has come to a close, we can look ahead to all of the exciting milestones planned for the Town of Edgewood in 2014. As you may imagine, there is a lot going on with Edgewood - thus, below are some of the highlights you can expect to enjoy during this 2014 New Year.

1. Sewer Bond Project – The Town of Edgewood has applied for a bond through the State Revolving Fund (SRF). The money received will go toward constructing additions and improvements to the sewage works of the Town including sanitary sewer lining, manhole rehabilitation and storm water control, together with all necessary appurtenances, improvements and equipment and all items contained in the Preliminary Engineering Report pursuant to plans and specifications prepared by Servies Engineering & Surveying, LLC. The bond amount requested is \$1,600,000.00. The Town is optimistic that the project will come in well below budget and help reduce the amount of infiltration into our sewer lines.

2. Street Paving – Winding Way, by the Edgewood Elementary School, is on our list for paving. Our Town Engineer will be compiling a list of areas that need attention. If you notice a particular road that is in need of repair, please contact the Town Hall.

3. Water Tower Repair – The Town of Edgewood received funding from Food and Beverage for the repair of our Water Tower. Hopefully, we will receive estimates soon and have the repairs done before summer.

Please remember to purchase your 2014 dog tag(s). Every dog living in Edgewood needs to have a dog tag!

Make sure you protect your water meter from the cold. If the bottom plate of the meter freezes, you will have to pay to have it repaired. With the cold weather, you need to have ample heat in areas of your home to prevent your water line from freezing.

If you have outside pets, make sure they have suitable shelter, fresh water, and food.

PARKING

Winter and snow have arrived, and as always we need your assistance in keeping the roads clear.

There is no parking allowed on the paved or main traveled part of any street within the town. Please make sure you are following this ordinance so the streets can be thoroughly cleared by the snow plows.

Any resident may file a written request for on-street vehicle parking for periods not to exceed eight hours.

Also, remember that snowmobiles are not allowed to be parked or driven in the parks and recreational areas, and should not be driven on the roads. Be sure you have permission from the owners if you are riding them on private property.
