Message From Clerk-Treasurer *Katherine Tanner*

Happy New Year! Now that 2014 has come to a close, we can look ahead to all of the exciting milestones planned for the Town of Edgewood in 2015. As you may imagine, there is a lot going on with Edgewood - thus, below are some of the highlights you can expect to enjoy during this 2015 New Year.

1. Sewer Bond Project – The Town of Edgewood has applied for a bond through the State Revolving Fund (SRF). The project has been approved and the bid process will soon begin. The money received will go toward constructing additions and improvements to the sewage works of the Town including sanitary sewer lining, manhole rehabilitation and storm water control, together with all necessary appurtenances, improvements and equipment and all items contained in the Preliminary Engineering Report pursuant to plans and specifications prepared by Servies Engineering & Surveying, LLC. The bond amount requested is \$1,738,069.00. The Town is optimistic that the project will come in well below budget and help reduce the amount of infiltration into our sewer lines.

2. Water Tower Repair – The Town of Edgewood received funding from Food and Beverage for the repair of our Water Tower. This project was scheduled for last year, but due to receiving bids in a timely manner and the weather, repairs should be made late spring or early summer.

Please remember to purchase your 2015 dog tag(s). Every dog living in Edgewood needs to have a dog tag!

Make sure you protect your water meter from the cold. If the bottom plate of the meter freezes, you will have to pay to have it repaired. With the cold weather, you need to have ample heat in areas of your home to prevent your water line from freezing.

If you have outside pets, make sure they have suitable shelter, fresh water, and food.

Pay Monthly Utility Bill by Using Direct Withdrawal

Happy New Year! By now all of you should be aware that monthly billing is in progress for the Water and Sewer usage. To make things easier for you, you can pay your Monthly Utility bill by using Direct Withdrawal!

How Direct Withdrawal (ACH Payment) works:

- Sign up by returning the Authorization for Direct Withdrawal at the bottom of this sheet
- You will receive notification of the payment amount at least ten days before the withdrawal date
- On the payment date, your payment will be withdrawn from your specified account
- Your payment is made automatically. No hassles, No late fees and No worries



We hope this new method will assist you in making your payments. Of course, the existing payment office and drop box located at the Town Hall will continue to be available for your convenience. To sign up for Direct Withdrawal, please complete the authorization application below.

Provisions for the Town of Edgewood Utilities Electronic Bill Payment

Payment Notice and Billing Questions

Your Town of Edgewood Water-Sewer bill will be mailed on the 10th of each month. From that day, you will have adequate time to plan for your automatic payment or contact us if there is any question about your bill. Your payment will be deducted from your designated account on the 21st day of the month or the next business day after the 21st day of the month.

Record of Payment

The amount and date of your automatic payment will be shown on your regular bank statement. This is your proof of payment. If there is a question about a payment, you must notify your financial institution and the Office of the Clerk-Treasurer within 30 days of the date of the bank statement on which the error occurred.

Availability of Funds

You are responsible for having enough money in the indicated account on the payment date. You will be charged the same as if a paper checked "bounced" should your payment be returned with insufficient funds. In addition, your Direct Withdrawal service may be cancelled if two payments are returned in a 12-month period.

Termination

This authorization will remain in effect until we receive written notice from you thirty days before the cancellation date or until your utility service has been terminated.

Account/Address Change

You are required to notify us of any account or address changes to ensure timely payments. You are responsible for submitting a new application when an account or address change occurs.

PARKING

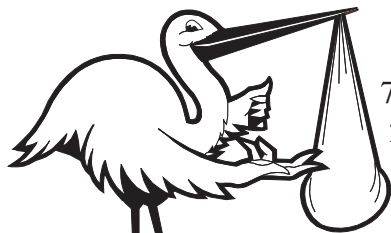

Another good habit to keep in 2015 is looking and listening for emergency vehicles. If an ambulance or fire engine is needed, call 911. Think about this,... flashing red and white lights on an emergency vehicle are there for a reason. You must give these vehicles the right of way.

Flashing blue and/or flashing green lights are on privately owned vehicles to help volunteers get to their station or to the scene of an emergency. By giving these vehicles the right of way, you help them arrive at their destination safer and faster.
