
"All the Charm of Yesterday With a Vision For Tomorrow"

Message From Clerk-Treasurer Katherine Tanner "REMEMBERING EDGEWOOD" by Ted Vinson



When my dear friend Theodore Vinson was six years old, his father would drive past what is now the Town of Edgewood and tell his son how Edgewood was growing into a special new community and might become a new town some-

day. This was in 1929. In 1951 Ted and his wife Eleanor bought their first home in which Ted still lives, 216 Donnelly Drive. Eleanor left us in 2009. The book begins with Ted's memories starting from 1926 – 2013. It is an ambitious attempt to tell the story of a town that grew from the vision of a man who wanted to develop a

"Restricted - Community" four miles west of Anderson, Indiana, on State Road 32. The man's name was Wade Donnelly. His vision grew into a town of 2000 residents and became the Town of Edgewood. Ted tells the story of Edgewood from his 63 years living in Edgewood and information gathered from 80 years of



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Message From Building Commissioner Julie Armington

Just a reminder to any residents wanting to place a swimming pool in their back yard:

According to Indiana State Swimming Pool code and our Town of Edgewood Ordinance 154.24, any above ground pool that is over two feet in depth and over 12 feet in diameter requires the issuance of a building permit by the Building Commissioner.

Some of the restrictions of this permit require fencing at least 5' in height, locking gates or covers, landscaping, and any other items deemed necessary for safety and appearance to the surrounding properties.
