# Patty's POINT of VIEW

## To All Who Use Edgewood Water and/or Sewer Services

The facts are difficult for the Town Council to spell out, but a requirement of the State Revolving Fund (SRF) sewer repair bond is that Edgewood maintains at least \$250,000 in the Town's Sewer Fund. Since Edgewood has been trying to pay the City of Anderson for the large volume of infiltration, and this Spring has been one of the "wettest" in a while... If Edgewood attempted to pay this debt, there would be a NEGATIVE balance in the Sewer Fund.

We are currently refiguring the final phase-in of rate increases for both water and sewer that will be easier to accept and still allow the Town to manage a balance in our Funds.

# Message From Clerk-Treasurer Katherine Tanner

With summer finally here, I would like to remind residents of a few courteous neighborhood tips.

#### Illegal Discharge into the Sewer/Storm Water System:

Please do not blow grass clippings into the street. The grass usually finds its way to the storm drain, clogging the drain and causing drainage issues. This is a violation of Town Ordinance.

**Noise Control:** There is an Ordinance that bans various kinds of noise ranging from excessively loud car stereos to non-muffled lawn equipment. It includes excessive noise originating from motor vehicles, personal stereos, barking dogs, and private residences when noise is received on public property.

**Fire Prevention:** Open burning is permitted for leaves and wood only in mesh containers with a lid designed for that purpose, not on the pavement. Fires should be attended at all times until completely extinguished. A fire must be extinguished if it creates an air pollution problem, a nuisance for neighbors, or a fire hazard.

No Parking Zones: Street parking is not allowed in the Town of Edgewood except for emergency vehicles, U.S. Postal Service vehicles, utility service vehicles, lawn service vehicles, vehicles operated by contractors, and other business or commercial vehicles, but only to the extent that the stopping, standing, or parking of such vehicles is necessary so that services can be provided to or work can be performed for Town residents, and then, only to the extent that the disruption of traffic and/or the blocking of streets within the Town is minimized.

I, Joe Cook and Mike Austin met with the City of Anderson leadership shortly after the public hearing. Both City and Town are working to resolve some of the issues discussed at the hearing. This project / outcome depend on the efforts of many. The SRF Bond requires that a rate increase be in place prior to the final approval and signing. This validates the ability of the Town to repay the SRF Bond.

On Monday August 3, 2015 the Town Council will have a public meeting at 5PM to receive bids for the sewer project. **Immediately following this, we will have the third reading of the water and sewer rate increase Ordinance.** Please realize that to move forward, we **must** implement this process.

# Pay Your Utility Bill On Line



You can now pay your utility bill on line with your credit card. Please visit our website: townofedgewoodin.us to make a credit card payment. There will be a fee imposed based on the amount you are paying. Please note that it takes two-three days to be processed.

If you receive a disconnect notice, you **MUST** pay the entire bill **BEFORE** the shut off date or you may have a gap in service. There is a \$50 reconnect fee added to your bill on the date of disconnect.

# **On-Street Parking**

There is NO PARKING allowed on the paved or main traveled part of any street within the town. However, any resident may file a written request for on-street vehicle parking for periods not to exceed eight hours. Please park on only one side of the street so the normal traffic and emergency vehicles can get through.
