What a summer! The great Indiana weather is here and we have been busy with a number of wonderful projects and activities for Edgewood. Make sure you visit the school bus stop at Edgewood Drive and Cherry Road. The Edgewood bench is nestled around an array of beautiful plants and a weeping cherry tree.

Please make sure you trim any bushes or trees that are blocking street signs or stop signs on your property. Things have really started to grow, and trimming and pruning are very important in order to keep your property neat and clean. Overgrown foliage attracts wild animals and can become a mosquito incubator. If you have a fence, please remember that you need to maintain both sides of your fence.

There are several homes for sale in Edgewood. In many cases, residents are trying their best to make the property look good and attract quality buyers. Please do your part too. Make sure to keep your place neat and uncluttered. It helps your neighbor and attracts great potential residents to our area.

As a reminder, water and sewer bills are mailed around the 10 th of each month and are due ON OR before the 21st of each month. If payment is not received on or before the 21st there will be a penalty added to your account. Once you are two months behind, you will receive a disconnect notice. Payment must be paid BEFORE the disconnect date in order to avoid a \$50 shut off fee and interruption of water service. The FULL amount must be paid if you receive a disconnect notice to continue service.



There are times that many of us forget to use basic common sense. Following are a few reminders I hope all of us will use.

- 1** The neighbor's yard and along the streets are NOT your dog's bathroom.
- 2** You need to pick up after your dog – those plastic bags from Marsh and Payless come in handy for this task.
- 3** The street is NOT a compost pile for your grass clippings...the debris blocks the drain causing standing water and other drainage issues. It is a violation of the Town of Edgewood's Ordinances.
- 4** If you see or hear something that just does not seem right, call the Town Hall or the police department at 765-642-3200.
- 5** With the weather so nice, get outside, take a walk, and meet your neighbors!

The Final sewer lining will begin July 11 and last two weeks in the valley (Northwest Edgewood) weather permitting. If your sump pump is connected to the sewer line you may have a resin odor coming into your house especially Edgewood Place residents.

TOWN ORDINANCES

The Edgewood Police Department will be patrolling the town looking for Ordinance Violations in hopes of keeping our community beautiful and safe. We have already completed two full town inspections for violations. Several courtesy letters were sent to residents asking for violations to be corrected and over half were corrected. We thank those residents for their time and effort in accomplishing the correction. We would like to encourage the others to continue to work on correcting the violations identified with their property.

The violations we are patrolling for are but not limited to;

grass, weeds and all landscaping cut to a height of not more than eight inches of growth.

Keep property in a neat and orderly manner, so as not to detract from overall appearance of the neighborhood.

Shall not allow garbage, refuse, or rubbish to be thrown, piled, or remain thereon.

(Example, piles of sticks, limbs, tree branches, tree trunks, weeds, and/or leaves.

Improper plated or parked vehicles.

(Example, trucks, passenger vehicles, campers, boats, trailers of any type, commercial vehicle of any type)
Please help keep Edgewood beautiful and safe by maintain your property in accordance with the Town of Edgewood Code of Ordinances.
