

Halloween is just around the corner, and we again remind you of the local ordinances and some guidelines to keep our children safe.



Have fun and be safe!

- "Trick or Treating" shall be permitted only on the evening of October 31 between the hours of 6:00 pm to 8:00 pm. Only children under the age of 12 are permitted to trick or treat, and all trick or treaters must be accompanied by at by at least one adult over 18 years of age.
- Trick or Treaters should walk, not run, and should never cut across lawns or driveways, always being aware of traffic.
- Stick reflective tape on dark costumes it will help drivers see you.
- Screen candy before your children eat it. Toss out anything with opened or damaged wrappers and homemade treats, unless you know the giver personally.

RECREATIONAL VEHICLE PARKING (CAMPERS/BOATS)

The guidelines for Recreational Vehicle Parking are as follows:

- On the driveway setback 25 feet from center line of the road.
- If in a side yard: has to be on a hard surface (Ex. Pavement, concrete, or gravel) set back 5 feet from exterior property line.
- Properly registered.
- Boats must be properly covered.
