There are times that many of us forget to use basic common sense. Following are a few reminders I hope all of us will use.

- 1** Please do NOT park in the No Parking area in front of the town hall. Parking there can increase damage to your vehicle from another vehicle driving into the town hall parking area.
- 2** If you own a fence, it is your responsibility to keep both sides of the fence neat and tidy. Please don’t let weeds, poison oak, poison ivy, or other vegetation grow in the fence line. Make sure you get your plants, flowers, shrubs, etc. trimmed to avoid overgrowth.
- 3** Last month the post office was late delivering the water-sewer bills. Please note that if you do not receive your bill by the 12th of each month, you can call the office to get the amount due or stop in at the Town Hall.
- 4** Please restrain your dog from continuous barking, especially at night.
- 5** If you see or hear something that just does not seem right, call the Town Hall or the police department at 765-642-3200.

HALLOWEEN

Halloween is just around the corner, and we again remind you of the local ordinances and some guidelines to keep our children safe.



Have fun and be safe!

- "Trick or Treating" shall be permitted only on the evening of October 31 between the hours of 6:00 pm to 8:00 pm. Only children under the age of 12 are permitted to trick or treat, and all trick or treaters must be accompanied by at least one adult over 18 years of age.
- Trick or Treaters should walk, not run, and should never cut across lawns or driveways, always being aware of traffic.
- Stick reflective tape on dark costumes - it will help drivers see you.
- Screen candy before your children eat it. Toss out anything with opened or damaged wrappers and homemade treats, unless you know the giver personally.

RECREATIONAL VEHICLE PARKING (CAMPER/BOATS)

The guidelines for Recreational Vehicle Parking are as follows:

- On the driveway setback 25 feet from center line of the road.
- If in a side yard: has to be on a hard surface (Ex. Pavement, concrete, or gravel) set back 5 feet from exterior property line.
- Properly registered.
- Boats must be properly covered.
