Roll call was initiated after the pledge of allegiance. All members were present except Mr. Leak.

Fire Department

Chief Vanderbur reported on the various runs in the month of June. Chief Vanderbur reported that there were fourteen runs (eleven were medical and three were fire runs.) Chief Vanderbur gave an update on the new fire truck, Community Day, which will be held on July 30, 2016 from 11-4 at Edgewood Park. Chief Vanderbur requested he be allowed to use \$500 from the Fire Department Restricted Donation fund to purchase food for Community Day. All members voting aye, motion carried. Chief Vanderbur requested that council approve the purchase of lighting for the new fire truck which will be completed at the end of November. Discussion followed. Mrs. Norrick made a motion to approve the purchase for lighting of \$21,175.00. Mr. Cook seconded the motion. All members voting aye, motion carried.

Mr. Widing reported on the status of 215 Tower Road. Discussion followed. Mr. Widing asked the council to approve the Demolition Order. Mrs. Norrick made a motion to approve the Demolition Order for 215 Tower Road. Mr. Cook seconded the motion. All members voting aye, motion carried.
