

Minutes of the Regular Meeting of the Edgewood Town Council

The Meeting of the Edgewood Town Council was held April 15, 2019 at 5:00 p.m. at the Edgewood Town Hall, 3405 Nichol Avenue, Anderson, Indiana 46011. The following persons were present:

Ms. Farran called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m.

Roll call was initiated after the pledge of allegiance. All members were present.

**Continuance of the Hearing for 36 Colony Road**

The record of hearing determination was presented to the council. Action taken by the Town Board for the Town of Edgewood at the hearing relative to an order to vacate issued by the Building Commissioner for the Town of Edgewood. Discussion followed. All council members voted to sign the order.

**Fire Department**

Chief Vanderbur, Edgewood Fire Department reported on the fire and EMS runs during the month of March. There were a total of eight runs in March. Twelve runs were medical with seven transports and one fire run which turned out to be a false alarm. Chief Vanderbur informed the council and guests that there would be a Stop the Bleed seminar on May 18<sup>th</sup> at the Edgewood Fire Station.

**Police Department Report**

Marshal Ellingwood reported that there were 226 incident/case reports in the month of March. There were 78 arrests/citations broken down as follows: Marshal Ellingwood 6; Captain Briggs 23; Officer Barnes 9; Officer Aukerman 6; Officer Taylor 29; and Officer Robertson 5. The reserve officers, Officer Robertson worked 21 hours, Officer Lehman worked 24 hours and Part-time Officers worked 8 hours. Discussion followed.

**Water Operator's Report**

Mr. Thomas Brewer, Edgewood Water reported on the various activity for the Water and Sewer Department. Mr. Brewer informed the council that the mowers for this season had been delivered and that there might be a water leak somewhere in Edgewood. One of the Storm Water Lift Station pumps went down. Discussion followed.

Ms. Tanner reported that the court had a loss of \$396.03 for the month of March and from January 1, 2019 – March 31, 2019 there is a loss of \$8426.00. Ms. Tanner informed the members and guests that the BZA would be meeting on Thursday, April 18 at 5:30 p.m. at the Edgewood Fire Station.
