Opening of Street Paving Bids and Manhole Repair Bids

Discussion followed. Mrs. Norrick made a motion for Mr. Services to review each bid, making sure all documentation was included and to award the lowest bid amount to the contractors. Mr. Cook seconded the motion. All members voting aye, motion carried.

Fire Department

Chief Vanderbur, Edgewood Fire Department reported on the fire and EMS runs during the month of December. There were a total of eighteen runs in January. Sixteen runs were medical and ten of the sixteen were transports. There were two fire runs.
