Water Operator's Report

Mr. Thomas Brewer, Edgewood Water Operator reported on the various activity at the water plant. Mr. Brewer showed the council and guests a section of the old pipe with the iron build up. Police Department

Marshal Ellingwood reported that there were 136 incident/case reports in the month of September. There were 11 arrests/citations broken down as follows: Captain Briggs 5; Officer Naselroad 3; Officer Aukerman 2; and Officer Lehman 1. The reserve officers, Officer Robertson worked 21 hours and Officer Lehman worked 16 hours; Part-time Officers worked 61 hours.
