Ms. Farran called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m.

Roll call was initiated after the pledge of allegiance. All members were present.

Fire Department

Chief Vanderbur, Edgewood Fire Department reported on the fire and EMS runs during the month of April. There were a total of fourteen runs in April. Twelve runs were medical and six were fire runs. The Chief informed the council and guests that the Fireworks Display would be June 29, 2019 at Bloomers. Discussion followed.

Police Department Report

Marshal Ellingwood reported that there were 164 incident/case reports in the month of April. There were 21 arrests/citations broken down as follows: Captain Briggs 7; Officer Taylor 2; Officer Aukerman 2; Officer Robertson 5; and Officer Petty 5. The reserve officers, Officer Robertson worked 29 hours, Officer Lehman worked 35 hours and Part-time Officers worked 48 hours. Discussion followed. Mr. Leak asked the Marshal to look for grass clippings in the roads. John Grimes, 3530 Laurel Lane, asked if the police would check backyards along with the front yards. Mrs. Gunter, 4 Willow Road agreed that she would like to encourage the police to look at the backyards also. Discussion followed.

Water Operator's Report

Mr. Thomas Brewer, Edgewood Water reported on the various activity for the Water and Sewer Department. Mr. Brewer thanked Chief Vanderbur for helping to fill the pool at the Edge. The backup generator is currently being repaired. Mr. Brewer presented a quote for upgrading the meter reading software and equipment. Discussion followed. Mr. Cook made a motion to move forward with the Midwest Meter Upgrade subject to clarification on the pricing. Mrs. Armington seconded the motion. All members voting aye, motion carried.


Register of Claims
